## A New Generation of Filmmakers Goes Public UWinnipeg Announces Second Annual Student Film Festival

WINNIPEG – Manitoba's student filmmakers will have a chance to strut their stuff at The University of Winnipeg's Second Annual Student Film Festival, sponsored by UWinnipeg's Department of Theatre and Drama. The public is invited to this **FREE** event for screenings, a public forum, a film presentation, and Q&A with **Guy Maddin '78**, and a chance to be the first to see works by hot new filmmakers.

After the great success of last year's First Annual University of Winnipeg Student Film Festival, this year's event has been expanded to include post-secondary students from throughout Manitoba. More than 30 filmmakers will compete for awards in the categories of Best Screenplay, Best Cinematography, Best Editing, Best Actor, Best Actress, Best Director, and Best Film. The Awards Jury will be comprised of **Dave Barber** (Winnipeg Film Group's Cinematheque programmer), **Liz Jarvis** (Buffalo Gals Pictures), and **Brendon Sawatzky** (National Screen Institute). Audience members will have their say as they vote for Audience Favourite at the Thursday and Friday night screenings.
