DESIRE UNDER THE ELMS is the fiery story of the Cabots, a farming family whose patriarch has already buried two wives. While his three sons plot to gain control of their inheritance, Ephraim returns with a new wife, Abbie. Strong, passionate and seductive, Abbie longs for what we all crave – a deep, consuming love. And she's finally found her match. Her new husband's youngest son, Eben.

Drawing from O'Neill's own dark life, as well as ancient Greek tragedy, **DESIRE UNDER THE ELMS** drives furiously towards the heart of the question: what does the human heart truly desire?
