

### **50 YEARS OF KINESIOLOGY**

The first Kinesiology courses at UWinnipeg were developed by Dr. David F. Anderson in 1964. During the 1980s, the increased demand for sport-related, knowledge-based courses and labs led to the development of the Physical Activity and Sport Studies program. The establishment of the Department of Kinesiology and Applied Health ensued in 2003. Subsequently in 2012, the University launched the Faculty of Kinesiology, which comprises the Departments of Kinesiology and Applied Health, and Athletics. The naming of the Gupta Faculty of Kinesiology and Applied Health in June 2014 leads us into a new and exciting era.

## **OPENING OF THE UNITED HEALTH & RECPLEX**

The United Health & RecPlex, which opened in September 2014, is a state-of-the-art complex that includes the Thomas Sill Community Multi-purpose Room, a multi-functional turf field, the Rettie Family batting cages, a four-lane sprint track, a jump pit, a training gym with climbing wall, the inviting Drew Olson Student Lounge, and much-needed underground parking.

The addition of the Great-West Life Healthy Campus and Research Centre in the RecPlex provides enhanced research and teaching opportunities, creating a robust student experience in the classroom and the community. From an expanded Athletic Therapy Clinic to increased practicum opportunities, Kinesiology students will have the opportunity to engage with faculty in various hands-on research projects such as the Sun Life Diabetes Education and Awareness Initiative, the Heads Up Concussion Institute, among other research-focused and community programs.

The United Health & RecPlex provides learning opportunities for students studying in Kinesiology, additional training space for Wesmen teams, recreation space for all University students, employees, alumni, friends, and community access. In response to the recreation and wellness needs of area residents and the community at large, a Community Charter was enacted in 2012, ensuring everyone access to the facility. This will provide the surrounding community and students with a block-long wellness and recreation destination on Spence Street, the most significant facility of its kind ever built in the inner city.

Drs. Daya and Chander Gupta, one of Manitoba's top medical families, have made a generous and transformational donation to the Faculty supporting applied health research and programming, and facility and infrastructure enhancements.
